First Reading The creation of man and woman Genesis 1:26-28,31A
Readings should be chosen from Together for Life B1-B8. A friend or family member comfortable with public speaking may read this.

Responsorial Psalm Psalm 103:1-2, 8, 13, 17-18a
Responsorial psalms should be chosen from Together for Life C1-C7. Normally, the soloist/cantor of the church will sing this. It can be read if you prefer.

Second Reading The greatest of these is love 1 Corinthians 12:31-13:8A
Readings should be chosen from Together for Life D1-D10. A friend or family member comfortable with public speaking may read this.

Gospel Acclamation 1 John 4:8, 11
The Gospel Acclamation should be chosen from Together for Life E1- E4. Sung by soloist/cantor of the church.

Gospel Love, the greatest commandment Matthew 22:35-40
Readings should be chosen from Together for Life F1-F10. The Gospel is read by the priest/deacon.
